executing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold and delivered, and by these presents do bargain
sell and deliver unto the said Simon Stone, all the articles hereafter enu-
merated, to wit, Negro woman Bridget, and her son Joe, Pleasant Rachel
Bridget, (Arzyle, Jane, Ned & Ellen) her four Children and girl Mary, one
small Horse, one bay horse one old black Mare, eight head of Cattle, two
Sows and Pigs, one riding Chair and harness, three saddles, three Broadstar
the beds and three bedsteads and furniture, one sideboard, one Sofa,
one Tea table, six Windsor Chairs, one Carpet, four sets of Knives and forks
one set of earthen ware, table Cloths and towels and one set of window cur-
tains, also, all this present year's crop, both growing and green, consisting of eleven
Stacks of Oats all the flax, Flaxseed, and Corn. To have and to hold the above
bargained premises unto the said Simon Stone, his heirs executors administrators and
assigns for ever, and to no other intent or purpose whatsoever. In testimony whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this twenty sixth day of July in the year of
our Lord one thousand eight hundred and two.
