

This Indenture made this seventh day of Feb^r in the year of our Lord
 one thousand eight hundred and three Between Charles Kentley sen^r and
 Jacemine his wife of the County of Prince's Anne and Commonwealth of Virginia
 of the one part and John Bidella of the same place of the other part,
 Witnesseth, that the said Charles Kentley sen^r and Jacemine his wife for and
 in consideration of the sum of one hundred and three pounds current money
 of Virginia to them in hand paid the receipt whereof they do hereby acknow-
 ledge have bargained sold and delivered and by these presents do grant bargain
 sell and confirm alien enfeof and deliver unto the aforesaid John Bidella
 and to his heirs and assigns forever, one certain parcel or tract of Land
 lying and being in the aforesaid County of Prince's Anne and adjoining
 the lands of the aforesaid John Bidella on the North it being part of tract of
 Land which the said Charles Kentley purchased of the aforesaid John Bidella
 and Amy his wife the whole to contain thirty four Acs and one third of
 an Acre according to estimation to the same more or less from a dividing
 line run by Tho^s Mathis Surveyor, to have and to hold the said Land ten-
 tuments and appurtenances unto the said John Bidella and to his heirs
 and assigns forever to take, possess, enjoy, and to exercise upon the said
 Land free and clear from all debts and incumbrances of what nature
 kind or service from any person or persons whatsoever, and the said Charles
 Kentley sen^r and Jacemine his wife, for them selves their heirs and assigns
 hereby agree to warrant and forever defend the right of the aforesaid John
 Bidella unto the aforesaid John Bidella and to his heirs and assigns forever,

against any claims dues or demands of what nature or kind service from
 any person or persons whatever in witness whereof we the aforesaid Charles
 Kentley sen^r and Jacemine his wife have hereunto set our hands and affixed
 our Seals the day & year first above written.
