This Indenture made the twenty first day of January eighteen hundred and three Between John Johnson and Nancy his wife of the County
of Prince Anne and Commonwealth of Virginia of the one part, and
James Lewis of Prince Anne County and Commonwealth of Virginia of the other
part Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred
and thirty pounds seven shillings by the said James Lewis to them in hand
paid at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof
they do hereby acknowledge and thereof release and acquit the said James Lewis

his heirs executors and administrators have granted sold aliened transferred
and for finished and by these presents do grant bargain and sold alien
transfer and confirm unto the said James Lewis one certain parcel
of Land bounding and being in the County of Prince Anne known by
the name of distons containing by estimation one hundred and nine acres
of land for the same more or less Beginning at the corner back in Jamesons
line running north by a line of marked trees to James line thence running
eastly along of marked trees a red oak corner tree in the negro Swamp
thence south westerly by a line of marked trees to a holly in Jamesons line
thence along the said line to the station the same to contain one hundred
and nine acres of land more or less and all profits and all the estate right
and title and interest of him the said John Johnson and Nancy his wife
of and in the said premises To have and to hold the said one hundred
and nine acres of land more or less to have the said James Lewis and his
heirs and assigns forever and the said John Johnson and Nancy his wife and
their heirs and the single the premises bargain and sold with the appur-
tenances and to the said James Lewis his heirs and assigns forever Lastly
we the said John Johnson and his wife Nancy covenants and defends
against themselves and those of claiming any part thereof In Witness
whereof we the said John Johnson and Nancy his wife have hereunto set
