

This Indenture made this first day of Feb^r in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and three Between John Biddle and Amy his wife of the County of Prince Anne and Commonwealth of Virginia of the one part; and Charles Kenty, sen^r, of the same place of the other part (Witnesseth), that the said John Biddle and Amy his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred dollars to them in hand paid, the receipt whereof, they do hereby acknowledge, have bargained, sold, and delivered, and by these presents, do grant, bargain, sell, alien and convey, unto the aforesaid Charles Kenty, sen^r, one certain parcel or tract of Land containing by estimation fifty nine Acres and one third to the same once or less granted to the aforesaid Charles Kenty, sen^r, and to his heirs and assigns forever, lying and being in the aforesaid County the South end of the Plantation and land, whereon the said Biddle, now lives, as far as will contain the third part of the said Land and plantation or one third of the tract which formerly belonged to William Kenty, sen^r, of being the right of dower to the aforesaid Amy Biddle, To have and hold the said Lands tenements and appurtenances unto the aforesaid Charles Kenty, sen^r, and to his heirs and assigns forever, to take perfect enjoy, and to enjoy upon the said Land, free and clear from all services and incumbrances from the aforesaid John Biddle and Amy, his wife, their or either of their heirs or assigns in what nature or kind soever, and the John Biddle and Amy, his wife their and each of their heirs and assigns forever, do hereby agree to quit all claim right and title of the aforesaid bargained premises unto the Charles Kenty, sen^r, and to his heirs and assigns forever against any claims due or demand

of what nature soever from the aforesaid John Biddle and Amy his wife their or either heirs or assigns; The Witnesses whereof we the aforesaid John Biddle and Amy his wife have hereunto set our hands and affixed our seals the day and year first above written

This Indenture made the thirtieth day of November in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and two Between Samuel Cornick and Joel Cornick of the County of Prince Anne in the Commonwealth of Virginia Commissioners acting under a decree of the worshipful Court of the County of Prince Anne of the one part; and Thomas Cornick of the County and Commonwealth aforesaid, of the other part; Whereas in a Suit brought in the Court of said County by Amy Cornick widow and next of John Cornick deceased, and John and Mary Hayes Cornick Infants Orphans of the said John Cornick deceased by the said Amy Cornick their Mother and
