or Chief Magistrate of the said Commonwealth in fifteen hundred dollars
to be paid to the said James Monroe esquire this sum for the use of the
said Commonwealth for payment whereof well & truly to be made we
bind our selves and each of us our and each of our heirs Executors administrators
jointly & severally jointly by these presents sealed with our Seals and dated
this 6th day of December 1802.

The Condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the said George
Halson hath lately been Ordained a Minister of the Episcopal Church
And therefore if the said George Halson shall well and truly perform and
execute the trust exposed in him according to an act of Assembly entitled
an act to regulate the solemnization of Marriages then the above obligation
to be void or else to remain in full force & virtue.

thousand dollars to be paid to the said John Page esquire and his heirs
or for the use of the said Commonwealth for payment whereof well and
truly to be made we bind ourselves and each of us our heirs Executors
and Administrators jointly and severally jointly by these presents sealed
with our Seals and dated this 7th day of March 1803.

The Condition of the above Obligation is such that whereas the above bound
William Bishop is constituted and appointed by John Page esquire Governor
of the said Commonwealth, Collector of the Taxes in the said County of
Prince Anne for the year 1802 by Commission bearing date the 5th day of
January 1803. If therefore the said William Bishop do and shall truly
and faithfully collect inure amount for and pay the public taxes due for
the aforesaid year of 1802 as imposed and directed to be collected by Law
to the person or persons required and empowered by Law to receive the same
for the use of the said Commonwealth then the above obligation to be void
or else to remain in full force & virtue.
