with our Seals and dated this 7th day of March 1803.

The Condition of the above Obligation is such that whereas the above bound
William Bishop is constituted and appointed by John Page esquire Governor
of the said Commonwealth Collector of the Taxes in the said County of
Prince Anne for the year 1802 by Commission bearing date the 15th day of
January 1803. If therefore the said William Bishop do and shall truly
and faithfully collect every account for and pay the public taxes due for
the ensuing year of 1802 as imposed and directed to be collected by Law
to the person or persons required and imposed by law to make the same
for the use of the said Commonwealth then the above obligation to be void
otherwise to remain in full force & virtue.
