This Indenture made the thirtieth day of January in the
 year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and one Between
 David Lawson and Susannah his wife of the County of Norfolk and
 State of Virginia of the one part and John Thoroughgood of the County of
 Princeps Anne and State aforesaid of the other part, Witnesseth
 that the said David Lawson and Susannah his wife in consideration
 of the sum of Eighty pounds, lawful money of the State aforesaid to
 them in hand paid by the said John Thoroughgood at or before the making
 and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,
 have bargained and sold and by these presents do, and each of them doth
 bargain and sell unto the said John Thoroughgood his heirs and assigns
 for ever a certain piece of Land containing thirty seven and an half acres
 the portion or share of the said Susannah Lawson out of a tract of seventy
 five acres lying and being in Suggs Neck in the County of Princeps Anne
 which said Seventy five Acres, fell to the said Susannah Lawson and her
 sister Elizabeth Langley by the death of George Kenaball, and which has
 been divided between the said Susannah Lawson and the said Elizabeth Langley

the said Seventy five acres of land is bounded as follows. it joins the said
 of John Hunter, formerly Robin Mosleys on the west, John Thoroughgood on
 the east, John Hunters on the south and the branches of little creek on the
 north, together with all and singular the houses, barns, buildings, Stables
 yard, gardens, Orchards, land, tenements meadows, pastures commons,

 Lawson Susannah his wife likewise covenant that should any error rep-
