delivery of the presents the receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge and their
cof^s for every part thereof do hereby acquit exonerate & discharge the said Lewis
Dey his heirs & assigns by these presents, they the said Reuben & Mary & John
Casons have granted bargained sold aliened & confirmed and by these presents
doth grant bargain sell alien & confirm unto the said Lewis Dey his heirs
& assigns Two certain tracts or parcels of Land situate lying & being in the
said County and near the Runge Chapple Run Bounded as follows that
