him in hand paid by the said William Davy at the sealing and atta
ching of these presents the receipt the receipt whereof the said David Watters
and Nancy his wife acknowledge and every part and parcel thereof doth
quit release and discharge the said William Davy his heirs executors
Administrators and Aysgns forever hath granted bargained sold and confirmed
and by these presents doth bargain sell and confirm unto the said William
Davy his heirs and Aysgns forever One certain tract or parcel of Marsh
Land lying in the County of Prince Anne and on the North side of
Nanney Creek and bounded as followeth Beginning at a post on the edge of
Nanney Creek opposite to a pine on the corner of Thomas Olds land running
due north to a gut or myre bog to a post in the said bog and thence running
an easterly course to a post thence running due east to another post 15 chains
thence N 10 degrees E 16 ch. 18 links to a post upon the edge of an old ditch off
set to the mouth of Trap gull thence 16 ch. East down the said ditch 12 ch.
to another post thence 15 ch. to another post thence S 45 degrees E 10 ch.
to another post on the edge of the Bay thence E 2 west to the mouth of Nanney
Creek thence bound by the said Creek to the first station containing One hun
dred and twenty acres to be the same more or less with houses and profits there

for the better confining the said Marsh Land and premises hereby
granted without any manner of interruption of the said David Watters &
Nancy his wife their heirs Executors Administrators or any person or persons
