Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred pounds lawful money of Virginia to them the said Caleb Ward & Lettisha his wife in hand paid by the said Thomas Humphreys at or before the sealing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge they the said Caleb Ward and Lettisha his wife have granted bargained sold and confirmed and by these presents have granted bargained sold and confirmed unto the said Thomas Humphreys and his heirs One certain Tract or parcel of Land containing Sixty three and a half Acres more or less situate in the County of Prince Anne in the parish of Blackwater and bounded as follows beginning at a pine standing on the Creek from thence running northly along Hilkay Chapel line to a corner Holly in John Wilson line thence turning westly along J. Wilsons line to a branch thence southly along J. branch to the d. Creek thence southly along said Creek to the beginning it being the Land which accrued to Joannas surviving heir of Lettisha Ward Lettisha Bayld and all Houses buildings orchards waters ways watercourses peoples and appurtenances whatsoever to the said premises belonging or in any wise appertaining and the reversion and reversions remainder and remainders now under and remainders rents issues and profits therefrom and all the Estate right title of them the said Caleb Ward & Lettisha his wife of in and to the same To have and to hold all and singular the premises hereby bargained and sold with the appurtenances unto the said Thomas Humphreys his heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Thomas Humphreys

and his heirs and assigns forever free and clear of and from all clover and all and every other innumbrance of what nature or kind sower and lastly they the said Caleb Ward and Lettisha his wife and their heirs all and singular the premises hereby bargained and sold with the appurtenances unto the said Thomas Humphreys his heirs and assigns against whom the said Caleb Ward & Lettisha his wife their heirs and all and every other person or persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and for who depend by these presents In Witness whereof they the said Caleb Ward and Lettisha his wife have hereunto set their hands and seals the day and year just above written signed sealed and delivered
