 Letitia his wife have granted bargained sell, aliened and confirmed and by

these presents doth grant bargain sell alien and confirm unto the said The
 Kump and his heirs One certain tract or parcel of Land situate lying
 and being in the said County of Prince Anne of Blackwater containing
 Twenty Acres more or less and bounded as follows, to wit: Beginning at
 Blackwater river from thence running down the lane of marked trees to
