of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety eight in order to secure to the
said Amy Cornick the sum of one hundred & twenty two pounds sixteen shill-
ings which he the said James Braithwaite had borrowed of her estate a Debt
in trust for the conveying of a piece or parcel of Land lying and being in the
said County which the said Braithwaite bought of William & Francis Brock
as will more fully and at large appear by the records of the Court of the said
County reference being thereunto had; And Whereas the said James
Braithwaite hath since satisfied and paid off the said one hundred & twenty two
pounds sixteen shillings unto the said Amy Cornick, with all interest thereof; Now
this Indenture Witnesseth that the said Amy Cornick for & in consideration
of his the said James Braithwaite having fully satisfied and paid off the said one
hundred & twenty two pounds sixteen shillings with all interest thereon, hath &

This Indenture made the fourth day of May in the year of our
Lord, Eighteen hundred and one Between Lewis Dey and Fanny his
wife, of the County of Norfolk of the one part, and Anna Williamson of
the County of Princeps Anne of the other part, Whereas Charles William-
mson late of the County of Princeps Anne, by his last will and testament
dated on the sixth day of May in the year one thousand seven hundred
and eighty seven, did amongst other things, bequeath unto his wife during
her natural life, the use and profits, of one half of the tract of Land and
plantation whereon he then lived containing two hundred Acres, together with
the use and profits of one half of all the Houses and Orchards thereon, and whereas
the said Fanny Williamson, widow and relict of the said Charles Williamson
hath since his death intermarried with the said Lewis Dey. Now this
Indenture Witnesseth that the said Lewis Dey and Fanny his wife,
for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred pounds to them in hand paid,
by the said Anna Williamson at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents
the receipt whereof he hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained, sold, enfeoffed,
released and confirmed, and by these presents do grant bargain, sell, alien, convey
affirmance and confirm unto the said Anna Williamson her heirs and assigns
forever, all the right title, interest claim or demand which they the said Lewis
Dey and Fanny his wife have or can claim to the above mentioned Land and
Orchards by virtue of the will of the said Charles Williamson. To have
and to hold the said Land, Houses and Orchards with all other the
appurtenances unto the said Anna Williamson her heirs and assigns forever
the only proper use and behoof of her the said Anna Williamson, and of her heirs and assigns
forever, and the said Lewis Dey and Fanny his wife, for themselves, their heirs, executors
and Administrators, do covenant promise and agree, to and with the said Anna Williamson
her heirs and assigns that the aforesaid Land and appurtenances shall forever remain
be clear of and from all and every claim and demand, which accrued to them by the
