firmed and by these presents grant bargain sell alien & confirm unto the said
William Brewer his heirs and assigns all our right title interest claim
demand in and to two certain Tracts or parcels of Land formerly the
property of James Brewer dec'd and devised by him to his son James Brewer
who has since died intestate one of which is heir to his son James is be-

turning Southly along S. Butt line to a bush standing in William Soury
line thence turning westerly along S. Soury line along the road to the beginning
