firmed and by these presents grant bargain sell alien & confirm unto the said
William Brewer his heirs and assigns all our right title interest claim
I demand in and to two certain tracts or parcels of Land formerly the
property of James Brewer deceased and devised by him to his son James Brewer
who has since died intestate one of which is heir to his son James is be-
queathed by the said Jefry Hill, Mr. Rulingde, William Tener & this side

ned sold aliened confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sold alien
and confirmed unto the said John Woodard and his heirs and assigns one certain
Mesay or tract or parcel of Land contain Fifty acres to the same more or less
