 of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and one Between James
 Scary and Sarah his wife of the County of Princeps Anne in Virginia of
 the one part and John Woodard of the same place of the other part Wit
 nee so that the said James Scary to Sarah his wife in consideration of
 Six hundred dollars to them in hand paid by s^r John Woodard at or before
 the enacting and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof they doth hereby
 acknowledge they the said James Scary and Sarah his wife have granted bargain
 and sold alien confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sold alien
 and confirmed unto the said John Woodard and his heirs and assigns one certain
 Messuage or tract or parcel of Land contain fifty acres to the same more or less
 situate lying and being in Princeps Anne County and in the precinct of
 Blackwater adjoining on the lands of James Humphres William Scary &c
 Josiah Butt dec. and bounded as follows Beginning at a worn bench standing in
 William Scary &c Josiah Butt dec. line and running Northly along s^r Butt
 line to a bench standing in James Humphres line thence turning easterly
 to a gum standing on the east side of the road in s^r Josiah Butt line thence
 turning Southly along s^r Butt line to a bench standing in William Scary
 line thence turning westerly along s^r Scary line along the road to the beginning
 and all Houses buildings Orchards ways waters watercourses profits and
 appurtenances whatsoever to the said premises belonging or in any way app
 taining and the reversion and reversions remainder and remainders unto

James and profits thereof and also all the Estate right and title of them
 the said James Scary and Sarah his wife of in and to the same, To have
 and to hold all and singular the premises hereby bargained and sold
 with the appurtenances unto the said John Woodard his heirs and assigns
 to the only proper use and behoof of him the said John Woodard and his heirs
 and assigns forever free and clear of and from all debt and all and every other
 incumbrances of what nature or kind soever and lastly they the said James
 Scary & Sarah his wife and their heirs all and singular the premises hereby
 bargained and sold with the appurtenances unto the said John Woodard his
 heirs and assigns against them the said James Scary and Sarah his wife
 their heirs and all and every other person or persons whatsoever shall well
 vdo warrant and forever defend by these presents, In Witness whereof
 they the said James Scary and Sarah his wife have hereunto their hands
 & seals this day and Year first above written

 thousand three hundred and Ninety dollars in hand paid by the said Wil
 iam Scott to the said Richard Whitehurst the receipt whereof he doth
 hereby acknowledge and thus fore doth acquit and discharge the said William
