of doth acquit & discharge him the said William Shephard Junr His Esq: & Co:
or Assigns of him hath granted bargained sold and confirmed unto
the said William Shephard Junr his heirs forever One certain Tract or parcel
of Land lying being in the County aforesaid, being the said Sally Shephards
part of the land her father William Shephard Junr did possess with, and
the revenue & crouses remainder & remainders rents, Issues & profits thereof
with all the Estate, right, title Interest claim demand of her the said Sally
Shephard with the appurtenances To have & to hold the said Land and
all other the premises hereby Granted bargained & sold unto the said Wm
Shephard Junr during his life & his heirs forever to the only use & behoof of him
the said William Shephard peaceably to occupy & enjoy the said Land and all
other the premises hereby Granted without any manner of let, hind, suit,
trouble, or interruption of her the said Sally Shephard or her heirs Esq: & Co:
or any person or persons whatsoever unto this said Land or any thing thereunto
pertaining with full Warrant whereof she the
said Sally Shephard hath hereunto set her hand & seal the day & year first

This Indenture made the twenty third day of April in the year
our Lord Christ One thousand eight hundred and one. Between
William Heath and Lydia his wife in the County of Prince Anne
Virginia of the one part and William Land of the same place of the other
part, Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of Fifteen
pounds twelve shillings & pence to the said William Heath and Lydia his wife
in hand paid by the said William Land after before the sealing and delivering
of these presents that the aforesaid he doth her by acknowledge the
said William Heath and Lydia his wife have granted bargained and sold
and confirmed unto the said William Land and his heirs one certain Tract
or parcel of Land containing by estimation Twenty five acres more or less
and being in Pingo in the said County of Prince Anne and is bounded
as followeth to wit, Beginning at a come pine joining Charles Land line
turning and running a west course to corner a Gum joining Sally Barnes
line hence turning and running a southwest course to a corner black Gum
joining the same called Glane thence turning and running an east
course to a come gum joining Charles Land line thence turning and
running a southern course to the first station bounds and all ways roads
and watercourses paths and appurtenances whatsoever to the said parts
belonging or in any wise appertaining and the reversion and cessions
remainder and remainders rents, Issues & profits thereof and all the
estate right and title of him the said William Heath and Lydia his
wife of in and to the same To have and to hold all and singular
the premises hereby bargained and sold with the appurtenances unto
the said William Land his heirs and Assigns to the only and exclusive
use & behoof of him the said William Land his heirs and Assigns forever
free and clear of and from all Dower and all other incumbrance of what
nature or kind soever and Lastly the said William Heath and Lydia his
