 hereby acknowledge; hath Granted, bargained, sold and confirmed and
Ex^o, by these presents doth Grant, bargain sell and confirm unto the said
 Isaac Matthias his heirs and assigns forever, all that Plantation, tract
 or parcel of Land which was devised to me by my father Reuben Matthias
 deceased in his last Will and Testament as will fully appear by the record
 of the Court of the said County before being thenceinto had, it being the
 Manor plantation wheron my said father & Grandfather Henry
 Matthias did reside at the time of their death containing One hundred
 and acres be the same more or less according to the bounds thereof as
 held and enjoyed by my said father & Grandfather with all Woods,
