This Indenture of Release from Thomas Newton Surviving Administrator of  
John Hutchings deceased, to James Hunter Executor of Patrick Parker deceased, was proved according to law by the Oath of James Hume a Witness to the same and lodged for further  
proof and at another Court held for the aforesaid County on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of May 1801  
the said Indenture was further proved by the Oath of Wm. F. Hume a Witness  
to the same and lodged for further proof, And at another Court held for the said  
County on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of July 1801, The said Indenture of Release was fully proved  
by the Oath of William Davy a third Witness to the same and ordered to be Recorded.

This Indenture made the fourth day of April in  
the year of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred and one between  
Joseph Simeon and Mary his wife of the County of Princeps Anne in Virginia  
of the one part and George Booth of the same place of the other part  
Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of Fifty seven  
pounds fifteen shillings specie to the said Joseph Simeon and Mary his wife  
in hand paid by the said George Booth at or before the sealing and deliver  
ing of these presents that the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge  
to the said Joseph Simeon and Mary his wife have granted bargained and  
sold and confirmed unto the said George Booth and his heirs one certain  
tract or parcel of Land containing by estimation Sixteen and three quarters  
Acres more or less lying and being lying in the said County of Princeps Anne  
and is bounded as followeth to wit beginning at a pine stump joining  
Elizabeth Mathias land on the eastern part of the said bargained  
land running a northern course by a line fence unto a corner then joining  
James Whitehursts land thence turning and running a western course down  
a lane to the north river person joining the said Whitehurst still thence  
turning and running a southern course binding the said person to the  
first station bounds and all ways waters and watercourses profits and
