This Indenture made the first day of April in the Year
 of our Lord Eighteen hundred Between Thomas Newton surviving
 Administrator with the Will annexed of John Hutchings deceased of the
 Borough of Norfolk and Commonwealth of Virginia of the one part, And
 James Hunter of said Borough and Commonwealth executor of the last
 Will and Testament of Patrick Parker deceased of the other part, where
 as the said Patrick Parker was in his lifetime indebted to the said
 Thomas Newton as administrator aforesaid in the Sum of five hundred

and twenty two pounds, five shillings and two pence current money of Virginia
 and in order to secure the payment of the same did convey to him in trust
 two Tracts or parcels of Land situate lying and being in the County of
 Princeps Anne the one containing four hundred and thirty four Acres
 more or less, and the other containing two hundred Acres more or less as
 by said deed bearing date the eighth day of June one thousand seven
 hundred and ninety five and recorded in the Court of Princeps Anne
 reference being thereunto had well more fully appears, And Whereas
 the said James Hunter as Executor aforesaid hath this day paid to the
 Thomas Newton as Administrator aforesaid the said sum of five hundred
 and twenty two pounds five shillings and two pence with the interest thereon
 amounting in the whole to the sum of Six hundred and forty seven pounds
 eighteen shillings and nine pence, Now this Indenture Witnesseth
 that the said Thomas Newton as surviving administrator with the
 Will annexed of the said John Hutchings for and in the consideration of
 the said sum of six hundred and forty seven pounds eighteen shillings
 and nine pence, to him in hand paid by the said James Hunter at and
 before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged, Hath released and released and by these presents doth release
 and release unto the said James Hunter as executor of the last Will and testa
 ment of the said Patrick Parker all the Right, title, Interest, use and trust
 of him the said Thomas Newton as Administrator aforesaid of in and to the
 aforesaid two tracts of Land with their and each of their appurtenances con
 veyed by the said Patrick Parker to him in Trust as aforesaid, In Witness
 whereof the said Thomas Newton as Administrator aforesaid hath here
 unto set his Hand and seal the day and year first herein mentioned,
