of Virginia in hand paid by the said Caleb Etheridge to the said Malbon  
Kilgore the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge and therefore doth  
quit and discharge the said Caleb Etheridge and his heirs and havegained  
said bargain sold and delivered and by these presents do grant bargain sell  
and deliver unto the said Caleb Etheridge and his heirs a certain tract or par  
cel of Land containing Ten Acres lying in Punge and bounded as follows  
Beginning in Henry Newmans patent line on the westward side of the  
main road running east to the said Newmans patent line in the swampy being  
part of the land formerly belonging to Richard Salmonson deceased, it being two fifts  
full the land the said Richard Salmonson owned and running from east  
to west to have and to hold the said tract and parcel of Land to the
