that for and in the consideration of the sum of twenty pound current money
of Virginia in hand paid by the said Caleb Etheridge to the said Malbon
Kilgore the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge and therefore doth
quit and discharge the said Caleb Etheridge and his heirs and have gun-
ted bargained sold and delivered and by these presents do grant bargain sell
and deliver unto the said Caleb Etheridge and his heirs a certain tract or por-
cel of Land containing Ten Acres lying in Prange and bounded as follows
Beginning in Henry Newmans patent line on the westward side of the
main road running east to the said Newmans patent line in the swampy boggy
part of the land formerly belonging to Richard Salmonson, it being two fifths
part the land the said Richard Salmonson owned and running from east
to west to have and to hold the said tract and parcel of Land to the
said Caleb Etheridge and his heirs and assigns forever, with all its appur-
tenances hereto belonging or in any wise appertaining to the only proper

sum of forty pound specie to the said Cadar Mason to him in hand
paid by the said William Heath at the enrolling and delivering of this
presents the receipt whereof the said Cadar Mason and Peggy his wife
acknowledgeth and every part and parcel thereof doth acquit release
and discharge the said William Heath his heirs Executors admin-
istrators and Assigns forever hath granted bargained and sold
and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell and confirm
unto the said William Heath and his heirs one certain tract or parcel of Land
containing by estimation Fifty Acres to the same more or less lying and being
in Prange Six broad Neck and is bounded as follows, to wit Beginning at a
