paid by the said William Heath at the enacting and delivering of this  
presents the receipt whereof the said Cadar Mason and Peggy his wife  
acknowledgeth and every part and parcel thereof doth acquit release  
and discharge the said William Heath his heirs Executors admin-  
istrators and assigns for ever hath granted bargained and sold  
and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell and confirm  
unto the said William Heath and his heirs one certain tract or parcel of land  
containing by estimation fifty acres be the same more or less lying and being  
in Range Six broad Neck and is bounded as follows, to wit: Beginning at a  
 Gum joining James Luncas land from thence running on south west course  
joining William Luncas line from thence running north west course joining  
the North piece by a parcel of marked trees an easterly course from thence  
running south east course joining James Luncas land to the first station the  
said land Col. John Nichols once awarded and sold as well fully appear
