Virginia and Elias Williams of the other part in Currituck & State North
Carolina. Witnesseth that present in consideration of the sum of two
pounds ten shillings currant money to the said Reuben Cason and Mary
his wife in hand paid by the said Elias Williams at or before sealing and
delivery of these presents the receipt whereof they doth acknowledg and knowt

doth acquit and discharge the said Elias Williams his heirs and assigns
by these presents the said Reuben Cason and Mary his wife hath Granted
bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell alio
and confirm unto the said Elias Williams and his heirs a certain tract
or parcel of Marsh Land containing Twenty five Acres more or less lying
in the County of Prince Anne it being part of the Marshland Granted
Thee, Walke by a grant or patent and is part of the marsh Woods called
Intell Woods and the revenue and revisions remainder and remainans
rents Issues and profits thereof and also all the Estate right and Title
