Floyd of the County of Princeps Anne in the Commonwealth of
Virginia of the one part, and Frederick Doush of the aforesaid
County and Commonwealth of the other part, Whereas the said
Frederick Doush on the twentieth day of December in the Year of
our Lord One thousand seven hundred and Ninety nine purchased
of the said John Floyd a Tract or parcel of Land with the appurten-
ances lying and being in the aforesaid County, containing Two hundred
