This Indenture made the twenty fourth day of February
in the Year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and one, Between John
Reade of the County of Prince Anne and Commonwealth of Virginia
of the one part, and George Vashon of the said County and Commonwealth
of the other part. Witnesseth, that for and in consideration of the sum of
Seven hundred dollars to the said John Reade in hand paid by the said
George Vashon at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the
receipt whereof he doth hereby confess, and thereof, and of every part thereof,
doth hereby acquit, exonerate and discharge the said George Vashon his
heirs, executors and administrators by these presents. As the said John
Reade hath granted, bargained, sold, alredy released, and confirmed,
and by these presents, doth grant, bargain, sell alredy release and confirm
unto the said George Vashon all that Lot of land which was bequeathed

unto the said John Reade by his uncle James Timmon, situated in the
Town of Hampsville in the said County, adjoining the land of Anthony
Walker and William Nimmes deceased, and bounded as follows to wit
Beginning at a stone near the corner of said Reade's lot and running
north eighty and an half degrees east, two hundred and eighteen feet and
an half to the corner of William Nimmes lot, thence along his line
south two degrees east, two hundred and twenty seven feet and three qua
ters, thence south eighty eight degrees west two hundred seventeen and
three quarters feet, and thence north two degrees west two hundred feet to
the beginning, with all houses, Buildings, ways, waters, watercourses,
profits commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever tha
