branch and bounded by the same to the road then down the road North
eastwardly to the corner of a small thicket thence N 13° degrees E 130 links
N 75 to the Marsh line thence to the first station for Nineteen Acres
of Land and on for with rents issues and profits thereof and all the
Estate right and title interest claim and demands whatsoever of him the
said Willoughby Whitehurst and Francis his wife his heirs Executors
Administrators and Assigns or either of them of in or on to the same and
every part and parcel thereof with the appurtenances, To have and
to hold the said Tract of Land and singular the appurtenances
