or parcel of Land lying in the County of Prince Anne and on  
the south side of Nanny Creek and bounded as followeth begin  
ning at the marsh and running by a line of marked trees bind-  
ing on the land of Thomas Old and Jose Morris to a corner in  
Charles Maulbous line thence running eastwardly to a gutter boggy  
Marsh and bound by the same different courses round a point  
to Nanny Creek thence binding on the said Creek to the first  
station for one hundred acres more or less being the whole of  
the Land that the said Whitehead owned or possessed on the  
south side of Nanny Creek with all Houses Entails rents issues  
and profits thereof and all the Estate right title interest claim  
and demand whatsoever of him the said John Whitehead and Ann  
his wife his heirs executors administrators and assigns or either  
of them of in or onto the same and any part and parcel thereof  
with the appurtenances To have and to hold the said  
tract of Land with all and singular the appurtenances hereby  
granted or intended to be granted with the said William Dawley  
his heirs executors administrators or Assigns to the only proper  
use and behoof of him the said William Dawley his heirs and  
Assigns forever and the said John Whitehead and Ann his wife  
for themselves their heirs executors Administrators doth con-  
sent to and with the said William Dawley his heirs and Assigns  
that he the said William Dawley his heirs and assigns shall

forever peaceably and quietly hold possess and enjoy the said  
land with the appurtenances without the molestation or inter-  
ruption of any person or persons and the said John Whitehead  
and Ann his wife his heirs Assigns shall and will at any  
time or times hereafter make and execute all such other convey-  
ances or assurances for the better confirming the said Land and  
premises hereby granted with the appurtenances without any  
manner of let suit trouble or interruption of the said John  
Whitehead and Ann his wife their heirs executors Adminis-  
trators or any other person or persons whatsoever and the said  
John Whitehead and Ann his wife their heirs and assigns shall  
and will further warrant and defend the same with the appur-  
tenance In witness whereof the said John Whitehead  
and Ann his wife hath hancunt set their hands and seal  
the day and year first above written
