monwealth of Virginia on the one part, and Willoughby Whitehurst
of the County and Commonwealth aforesaid of the other part,
Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of two
hundred and Sixty pounds current money of Virginia to
him in hand paid by the said Willoughby Whitehurst at their
sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof William
Dodge and Sarah his wife acknowledge and every part and
parcel thereof doth acquit release & discharge the said Willoughby
Whitehurst his heirs Executors Administrators and assigns for
ever hath granted bargain sold and confirmed and by these pre
sents doth grant bargain sell & confirm unto the said Willoughby
Whitehurst his heirs and assigns forever, One certain tract or
parcel of Land lying in the County aforesaid containing fifty one
Acres be the same more or less it being the Land I bought of James
Dawley with rents issues and profits thereof and all the Estate
right and title interest claim and demand whatsoever of him
the said William Dodge and Sarah his wife his heirs Executors
administrators and assigns or either of them of in or unto the
same and every part and parcel thereof with the appurtenances
To have and to hold the same Tract of Land with all
and singular the appurtenances hereby granted or intended to
be granted with the said Willoughby Whitehurst his heirs Executors
