by the said William James at or before the sealing and delivery of
these presents the receipt whereof he doth hereby acquit exonerate and
discharge the said William James his heirs and Assigns by these pre-
sents that the said Tully Mosley and Frances his wife have granted
bargained sold aliened and confirmed and by these presents do grant
bargain sell alien and confirm unto the said William James his heirs
& Assigns one certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the
County of Princeps Anne it being the land I bought of Jonathan Jam-
to the south side of Charley Chapple containing One hundred and
twenty Acres more or less adjoining Caleb Dawsley to the west and Tully
Doudge to the south & Henry Smith to the east as beneath is con-

dred and twenty Acres more or less, To have and to hold
the s^d bargained premises with the appurtenances thereto belong-
ing or in any wise appertaining unto the s^d William James and his
