This Indenture made the seventh day of September  
in the year of Christ one thousand eight hundred nine Between  
Anthony Walke Executor of Anthony Walke esq; of Prince George  
County, of the one part, and William Gornot, of the said County  
of the other part; Witneseth that for & in consideration of  
the sum of one hundred eighty three pounds thirteen shillings &  
five pence to the said Anthony Walke Esq; aforesaid, in hand  
paid by the said William Gornot, the receipt whereof he doth hereby  
acknowledged, to the said Anthony Walke Esq; as aforesaid, hath  
granted, alined, & Confirmed unto the said William Gornot, this  
his heirs, a piece of Land lying in Pungo, being part of the same which

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had been mortgaged by John Achips to Anthony Walke, Esq;  
at Auction, by a decree of Prince George County Court dated  
the 8<sup>th</sup> day of March 1798 bounded as follows; Beginning at a  
Gum near the pecoson, running across the Plant, N 84 E 55 poles  
to a cedar bush at the road, thence along the same N 84 E 35 poles  
to a stake at Brooks corner, thence N 87 E to the back line joining  
the Land which belongs to the Heirs of Geo. Achips, thence S 35 W 10  
cornered Oak, thence along Francis Achips's line S 35 W 133 poles to a  
black gum, thence S 77 W 146 poles to a post at the road, thence S  
77 W 72 poles to a cedar by the pecoson, thence along the Pecoson to  
the gum at the beginning containing about Sixty five & 1/2 acres to the  
same more or less, with the appurtenances belonging to the premises,  
full right & interest in the same to have and to hold, the Land  
hereby conveyed, with the appurtenances, unto the said William Gornot,
