in the year of Christ one thousand eight hundred one Between
Anthony Walke Executor of Anthony Walke dec. of Princeps Anne
County, of the one part, and William Gornale, of the said County
of the other part; Witnesseth that for & in consideration of
the sum of one hundred & eighty three pounds, thirteen shillings, &
five pence to the said Anthony Walke Esq. as aforesaid, in hand
paid by the said William Gornale, the receipt whereof he doth hereby
acknowledged, he the said Anthony Walke Esq. as aforesaid, hath
granted, aliened, & confirmed unto the said William Gornale, his
heirs, assigns of Land lying in Princeps, being part of the same which

had been mortgaged by John Achips to Anthony Walke, late
at Auction, by a decree of Princeps Anne County Court, dated
the 8th day of March 1798. bounded as follows: Beginning at a
Gum near the pocrson, running across the Plant, N 84 E 55 poles
