negroes should be sold & the money equally divided between my three daughters
Mary & Elizabeth Bray; & if I give & bequeath to daughter Elizabeth Bray a negro
Named Hanwell & her increaseable heirs for ever I give & bequeath to her
increaseable son my two youngest daughters Mary & Olive Bray to whom & their issue
for ever. -- I give & bequeath to my loving wife the plantation whereon I now live during
life & after her death to be sold the money to be divided equally amongst all my
children. -- It I give & bequeath to my wife Mary Bray all y^e rest of
estate & stock that I am now possesse^d withall, I also nominate & appoint her my wife
to be my whole & sole executrix of this my last will & Testament whereunto I
