Prince's Ann April 9th 1734. In the Name of God Amen I Edward Cannon of Prince's Ann County being sick & weak in body but of perfect mind & memory knowing that it is appointed for all men to die doth ordain this to be my last will & Testament & first of all I give & bequeath my soul to god that gave it and my body to the Earth to be buried in a Christian like & decent manner & as for my worldly goods I give & bequeath of the same as follows: - I promis I give & bequeath to my loving wife Elizabeth Cannon the sum of my negro boy called Ned during her natural life. - Then I give & bequeath to my beloued son John Cannon all my lands to him & his heirs also I give him my negro boy Ned to him & his heirs for ever also fine Cows & Calves also three doles of Lamb also one Cider & Schott also four Sows & two Pigs also an heif furniture & bedding also one Owl also two powder Drifts too bacon & two plates also one gun one not to him also a two powder Drifts too bacon & two plates also one gun one not to him and his heirs for ever: and all the rest of my Estate I give & bequeath to my loving wife Elizabeth Cannon to her & her heirs I also appoint & ordain my loving wife my holde & soile Exec. of this my last will & Testament
