Princess Ann April 4th 1734. In the Name of God Amen I Edward Cannon of Princess Ann County being sick & weak in body but of perfect mind & memory knowing that it is appointed for all usen to die doth ordain this to be my last will & Testament & first of all I give & bequeath my soul to god that gave it and my body to the Earth to be buried in a Christian like & decent manner & as for my worldly goods I give & dispose of them as follows: - I primum I give & bequeath to my loving wife Elizabeth Cannon the use of my negro boy called Ned during her natural life. - I then I give & bequeath to my beloved son John Cannon all my lands to him & his heirs also. I give him my negro boy Ned to him & his heirs for ever also five Cows & Calves also three ewes & lambs also: one lberd & chof also four Sows & twenty piggs also: one bed & furniture & bedstead also: one oval Table also two powder dishes two basons & two plates also: one gun none not to him and his heirs for ever: and all the rest of my Estate I give & bequeath to my loving wife Elizabeth Cannon to her & her heirs & also appoint & ordain my loving wife my whole & sole Ex^{rs} of this my last will & Testament
