In the Name of God Amen I Edward Mosley Junr of Parish of Lincolne in County of Middlesex being sick & weak in body, but of sound mind & disposing memory thanks be to almighty God for the same calling to mind the uncertainty of this Transitory life & that its appointed for all men once to die have thought fit to make this my last will & Testament whereby I bequeath my soul into the hands of my Creator who for his great mercies hoping by his merits & Intercession of my Saviour Jesus Christ to obtain forgiveness of all my sins & a joyful resurrection at the last day & for what so else I am possessed with do bequeath & dispose of, in the following manner: Imp: I give unto my loving wife Sarah Mosley my negro man slaved called neke to her & her heirs for Ever: It I give unto my illegitimate son Robert Mosley my negro man slaved called Jack to be delivered unto him at the time when he shall come to the age of Twenty one year or on day of my wife's death which I have first happen to my said wife to have: I do give & labour of said negro until then: It I give unto my said wife one good feather bed & furniture belonging to it which now stands in the Chamber above stairs also a horse called friend the said saddle half a dozen aper napkins & Table cloth: It I give unto my above said illegitimate son Robert Mosley & his heirs of his body lawfully begotten for Ever the plantation land & appurtenances thereto belonging whereon now live also unto my sister Sarah Pool & her priviledges of one room in my now dwelling house so long as she continues a widow: It I give unto my said son Robert Mosley & his heirs for Ever fifty acres of Swamp land lying in the Eastern branch & near the land of Mr John Roney & that which my father purchased of Capt John Mosley also to my brother Palmer Mosley half a year or schooling to be paid for by my Exor out of my personal Estate: It I bequeath unto my said Robert Mosley & his heirs for Ever my negro woman called Phillis with all her Inward also one young mare & horse now running & grazing on the land of Capt George Hancock one large Iron pot containing Iron gallons one small Iron pot containing three gallons one Iron spit one Iron woodge one Iron post one black walnut Table one Cup board two wainscot chairs one couch half a dozen of my best wood on bottom chairs one chest marked EM with the date of the year of the said my best sword one small Trunk half a dozen of new powder plates one point Taward of powder one quart powder Taward one cane with an Ivory head marked EM one of my best feather beds one bolster one pair of good Shirts one blanket one good rug with a pillow one good mat one Cord one dozen of virgin Diaper napkins one Table cloth to him & his heirs for Ever to be delivered him when he attains the age of Twenty one year or always provided & upon this condition that if my above said son dies before he attains the said age then the labour of the before specified Negroes given him up by this will unto my loving brother Palmer Mosley to be delivered him immediately after the decease of my said Robert Mosley my son if he happens to die before the
