

August 1713 The Last will and Testament of Elinor Wells in the first place I bequeath  
 God that gave it and my Body to be buried in Sacred Ground as for my personal Estate in the first  
 place I give one Chest Lock and Key to my daughter Ann and so many feathers as will fill a good  
 one gallon plate Item I give unto my daughter Mary one lining spinning wheel and one large  
 travelling Item I give unto my daughter Elinor one Heifer yearling Item I give unto my daughter  
 Sarah one Heifer yearling and one plate Item I give unto my daughter Elizabeth one  
 Cow and Calf and one Looking Glass and one plate Item I give unto my daughter  
 Owen Wells one feather Bed and bolster and all that belong to it Item I give him one  
 pot and putchess Item I give more unto him one Cow and Calf and one Cow without  
 a Calf and a Heifer yearling and one Iron Spade and two putch Baskets and one great  
 Earthen pott three Choppes and one Little Gable I give unto my Son Richard Wells one  
 feather Bed and Bedstead and all that belong to it next I give him one pair of Mill Stones  
 and one frying pan and one great Chest with a Lock and Key and one Stone Jug containing two  
 Gallons and one Cuck one Gable one putch tankard two Earthen butter potts and one Cow and one Calf  
 and two dry Cows and a two year old Heifer two putch plates and three Choppes one Sixty Gallon  
 Cask and one barrell and two Earthen pans two or three spoons and after all the debts be paid  
 which is about three hundred pounds of pork and to kill for the house use then what is left to  
 be for my Son Richard Item I give two young Steers to kill for the use of the house Item I give  
 one horse to my Son Owen and my Son Richard if they can sell him to have share and share if  
 not then for the use of the plantation Item I give to my Son Owen one old Cask and I give  
 unto my Son Richard one Bible and all barrells and Lumber Except Richards two Cask for the use  
 of the plantation and so I make my Last Will and Testament my whole Executor as witness my hand this 17 day  
 August 1713
