

body lawfully begotten but for want of such heir to fall to my son Peter Herbert his heirs; my desire is that if either of my sons before mentioned shall have a desire to sell their land I give them full power to sell the one to the other or other wife and if they cannot agree as to the value of the same I give full power to the other to sell the same for such price as he shall think fit and I give unto my son Thomas Herbert my plantation which he now lieth together with as much land adjoining to said plantation which he now lieth together with as much land adjoining to said plantation for ever Impremus I give & bequeath unto my son John Herbert all the remainder part of the said tract of land whereon I now lieth to him his heirs for ever my will & desire is that if either of my sons Thomas or John Herbert shall die without heir that the other shall enjoy the whole tract (Item) I give & bequeath unto my son Willoughby Herbert my negro man called Bell to him & his heirs for ever (Item) I give & bequeath unto my son Peter Herbert my negro man called Dayzor to him & his heirs for ever further my will & desire is that my sons shall all be at full age at eight teen years old to receive their portions & before them so less and at their own disposal (Item) I give & bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Bachelor one feather bed & what furniture belongs therunto (Item) I give & bequeath unto my daughter Mary Suggs one feather bed & one cow & yearling all which she hath in possession (Item) my will & desire is that all the remainder of my estate both personal & real wherewith whoso hands I come after my just debts paid shall be equally divided between my Grand wife beloved wife Elizabeth Herbert & my sons Thomas, John Willoughby and Peter Herbert & my daughters Dinah, Margret, Violet & Ann Herberts but my desire is that if my wife should remain unmarried she shall have the use of all this remaining part of my estate which is to be divided until the youngest of them which shall live shall come to age: but if she shall marry then their shall be an equal division made amongst them as aforesaid my wife keeping her own part & her children & my son Thomas to take his own part with the other his young brothers and sisters when they come I do appoint my wife Elizabeth Herbert and my son Thomas Executors of this my last will & Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the twenty fourth day of April 1728

I God Amen Elizabeth Smith of the County of Prince Georges in Virginia being of sound mind & memory but falling to mind of weakness do make and ordain this to be my last will & Testament I give & bequeath out into the hands of almighty God my Creator hoping through the merits of Jesus Christ to receive full pardon & remission of all my sins to be buried in a Christian manner this to rest in hopes of the last Day for what worldly goods the Lord of his Infinite Mercies will on me I give & dispose in manner following - I give & bequeath unto my young boy Mars also I give unto my daughter Martha Smith - I give unto my son George Smith one young bay horse - I give unto my son William Smith one Iron Spade also one large iron Smith one new chest also two small basons also I give & bequeath unto my son John Smith one Iron Spade also one large Iron Smith one new chest also I give unto my daughter Mary Smith one new feather bed with two small dishes also one bodson - also my will & desire is that my stock of hogs & Cattle & sheep all the remainder of my Estate that I have not given above may be equally divided amongst them all (Item) I make & ordain my daughter Martha Smith to be my true & lawful Executor of this my last will & Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 11 day of June Anno 1728
