from the Indians in the shoy of their bodies for ever - 5. I give & bequeath to my Son Israel
as my negro fellow man now to him & his heirs for ever - 6. I give & bequeath to my
Daughter Anne Nicholas & Elizabeth Nicholas my negro girl called by the name of Lucy -
I think her for ever & all her increase & for ever & for want of such her to fall to my
sons Isreal & William Nicholas to them & their heirs for ever - 7. I give & bequeath to my
Son John Nicholas three thousand Dollars & three hundred pounds to him his heirs
and his wife - 8. I give & bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth Nicholas three Cows &
one bull & two young heifers & one young horse to my daughter
Elizabeth - 9. I give & bequeath to my Son John Nicholas my horse & colt & a pair of two
cows of four - 10. I give & bequeath to my two sons Isreal & William
that all this increase to be equally divided between them to the age of
their mother - 11. I give & all my children that is not of age to live
