 of the County of Prince Anne and State of Virginia being
 very sick and weak of body best of a perfect and sound memo-
 ry thanks be given unto God for the same &c do with this
 proper and Convenient time to make this my last will
 and Testament in the following manner and form
 First I give to my nephew John Collins son of John Collins
 my plantation and tract of Land, and one Negro boy called
 Isaac to him and his heirs of his body, and for want of such
 heirs I give the said plantation and tract of Land &
 negro to be Equally divided among my Niece Mary Collins
 Elizabeth Collins, Mary Collins, and Franky Collins,
 Daughters of John Collins Dec^d to them and their heirs
 for ever but my desire is that my Plantation and Negro
 shall be turned out and only one half of the plantation
 to be turned over and the money arising from such
 to be for the use of my Nephew John Collins son of
 John Collins & his heirs Secondly I leave all my wearing
 apparel to be Equally divided between my brother Henry
 Collins my Nephew John Collins &c Thirdly I leave all
 the remainder of my Estate within and without doors to be
 sold to the best advantage by my Executors under named
 and the money arising from the sale thereof to bury me
 and pay my just debts and the remainder to be equally
 divided among my Brother John Collins dec^d Children
 and my Brother Henry Collins Children for to give them
 good Education &c
