 body I commit unto the earth to be decently buried hoping & steadfastly Expecting a joyful
 resurrection to life Eternal in bliss and happiness and for my Temporal Estate I
 do dispose of that as followeth: I give & bequeath unto my son Barn more
 & plantation where I now live with that & more land & woods ground belonging to by me
 since I first purchased I do by this my will give unto my son Twenty head of black and white
 & negro men of his younger brethren for & keeping of family lands & estate for them

I do give to my son Baron more my half part of piny Island with there Tract of land
 with Twenty head of cattle and all y^e rest of y^e movable in whatsoever I do fully give unto my
 son Baron more and to his heirs for ever and besides I give & boguath unto my son Francis
 more my plantation where now lieth with all y^e man who which belong to me. I give
 unto y^e said Sarah with all her increase to my son Francis & his heirs for ever I reserve
 full privilege in y^e best of y^e man for pasturing of forty head of cattle for one of my young
 men for ever and give unto my son Francis Twenty head of cattle with their increase for ever which
 he hath had y^e most part already so that must be made up and thirdly I give & boguath unto
 my son Thomas more ^{my plantation} which was given me by my father in law & according to that I did
 give to my son Thomas & his heirs for ever I give to my son Tho: y^e first child the young
 negro woman bring after it is a year old to him & his heirs for ever as fourthly I give and
 boguath unto my son John more one Tract of land which was given by will by my father
 Cornick & according let him have it. I give to my son John more one young girl negro being
 called Ross with all her increase and y^e first child which she bring & live to be a year old
 must be given to Thomas & fifthly I give & boguath unto my Daughter Elizabeth more one neg-
 girl about four years old Kate with all her increase to her & said Elizabeth her heirs lawfully begotten
 of her body & for the rest I leave her wholly to her mother's Care. So that my will is that my wife
 shall be my sole Executrix of this my last will & Testament for to remember y^e three young children
 she may make them at age when she pleases & she have all my power for order y^e Estate for her
 self and children my will is that my Daughter shall have Twenty head of cattle & I do give unto
 my wife full power all Debts & pay all Just Debts & do wrong her to perform this Testament & will
 according to y^e true contents & meaning hereof In witness whereof to this my last will & Testam^t
 contained in one sheet of paper I have set my hand & seal of Day & year first above written &
 so request & Desires me John Cornick & Cap^t Horatio woodhouse for to be our doors of this my
 last will
