Soul into hands of y<sup>r</sup> Lord Jesus Christ my maker & rescuer in this & certain hope of a  
joyfull resurrection & my body to y<sup>r</sup> earth to be decently buryed according to y<sup>r</sup> direction of my  
executors hereafter nominated; my will & desire is that all my debts be well & truly paid & all y<sup>r</sup> rest of  
my worldly estate as followeth: -- Item. I give & beg uath unto my Eldest Daughter Sarah ware  
one Cow & Calf: -- Item I give unto my Second Daughter Elizabeth Capps one Cow & Calf. It I give  
unto my third Daughter Jane Holley & Charles Holley her husband y<sup>r</sup> plantation wheron they now  
live with forty acres of Land more or less this said Land Divided by a Line of meadow Trees from  
Land which I now live upon this said forty acres of Land I give to Chas. Holley & Jane Holley &  
wife during their natural lives & after their decease to my grand-Son John Holley Son & heir  
Chas. Holley & Jane his wife to y<sup>r</sup> said John Holley & his heirs of his Body Lawfully begotten & his  
without such an heir then to his next heir in Law. -- It I give unto my grandson Geo: Ward one  
hoifer yearling at my decease I give unto my grand Son Richd. Capps one hoifer yearling. Item I  
give & beg uath unto my youngest Daughter Frances marsh my plantation which I live upon  
at my Land therunto belonging to her & heirs of her body Lawfully begotten & if she dies without  
such an heir then y<sup>r</sup> said Land & plantation to fall to her next heir in Law: & I give unto my  
daughter Frances marsh & above said plantation & Land together with one negro woman & all  
y<sup>r</sup> rest of my personal Estate within & without moneys & in monies & whatsoever belonging to  
me I do make her my whole sole Exec<sup>t</sup> of this my Last will & Testament revoking all other m  
any Goods whatsoever I do appoint my Trusty & well beloved friends Roger Fountain & John Moore  
my Trustees to see my will fulfilled according to my desire as witness my hand this 12. Day  
of January 1718
