In the Name of God Amen the twenty second Day of August in the year of our Lord God 1732: I George Smith of prince Anne County son of William Smith & Elizabeth his wife both deceased being weak in body but of perfect mind & memory thanks be to God for it & knowing that all are mortal I do make & ordain this my last will and Testament principally & first I give & recommend my soul to God who gave it unto me & for my body I commend it to earth to be buried at the discretion of my Executor and as Touching my worldly Estate that it hath pleased almighty God to bestow on me I give devise & dispose of & send in the following manner & forms - I give & bequeath unto my loving sister Elizabeth Smith her heirs for ever all & singular all my movable Estate excepting twenty shilings in cash which I have reserved. - I then I give & bequeath unto my loving uncle John Smith and his heirs & assigns for ever all & singular all my lands houses orchards that have or shall in any way so fall unto me from my deceased father I also give him the lands with the reversion of my goods already given away being twenty shilings in cash & said legacy to be paid immediately after my death by uncle John Smith - whom I likewise constitute make & ordain my only & sole Executor of this my last will & Testament all & singular all my lands & Tenements by him freely to be possessed and enjoyed & I do hereby utterly disallow revoke & disannul all & every other former Testament wills legacies requests & Executors by us in any way so before this time named will & bequeathed ratifying & confirming this to be my last will and Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this day & year above written
