 my loving wife Elizth: Woodhouse only y^e use & third of y^e profits & provisions of y^e afores^d plantation wth all

 tural life & no longer. I give unto my youngest son W^m: Woodhouse my negro man called mingo to be d:
 delivered to him when he cometh to y^e age of twenty one year or before that other my real & personal Estate I have
 not already given or given with proviso that it be equally divided between my loving wife Elizth: wth
 house & my three children that is to say Philip W^m: & Mary Woodhouse they first long & legal will & lawful
 debts. I do hereby constitute & appoint my loving wife Elizth: Woodhouse my whole & sole Ex^{or}: of this my last
 will & Testament In witness whereof I do have set my hand & seal this 23: day of April 1717
