my later and the uncertainty of this life do make & ordain this my last will & Testament
disallowing & making void all former wills & Testaments formerly made or caused to
be made by me in manner & form as followeth (viz.) I Imp: I bequeath my Soul to
almighty God my Creator & Redeemer who first gave me being in and by whom I
expect a glorious resurrection at the last day. I bequeath my body to y^e Earth the Common
mother of us all to be decently buried with Christian buriall according to y^e discretion of
my Excutrix hereafter mentioned for what worldly Estate it hath pleased y^e Lord to bestow
now with I give & bequeath as followeth: I give & bequeath unto my son Edward
Hack Mosloy phillis an negro for molatto woman & his her son which two said negroes
and their future increase I say I give unto my said son Edward Hack Mosloy that he
lawfully begotten of his body for ever but if in case my said son Edward Hack Mosloy shall
die before he hath such issue lawfully begotten or does attain to y^e age of twenty one years
then I give & bequeath y^e above said two negroes with all their increase unto my loving
wife Hannah Mosloy & to her heirs & assigns for ever. I give & bequeath unto my
loving wife Hannah Mosloy all my other negroes lands Tenements Jewels Gold & Silver
plate Cattle hogs & sheep household stuff & other my personal Estate & Real Estate that I
now possess with all or that I have any right or Title therein unto my above said loving
wife Hannah Mosloy her heirs & assigns for ever. In my last debt being first paid
out of my Estate - I do nominate & appoint an ordain my loving wife Hannah Mosloy
my whole & sole Excutrix of this my last will & Testament In witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand & fixed my seal this first day of November 1727
