 god who gave it up hoping through y^e merits of my blessed Saviour & redemer Jesus Christ to have a
 glorious resurrection at last day & my body I commit to y^e grave to be decently buried by my Exors
 her after named, & for what worldly goods it hath been pleased God to bless me with I give & bequeath as
 follows: - I give & bequeath unto my friend Tho: Delomars all my wearing Cloaths as
 much striped hollands as will make him two Jackets & breeches & as much white hollands as will make him
 one shirt & my riding black mare. - It I give unto my friend Hester walstone my negro man called
 Tommy during her Natural life & after her decease then to my two Loving Sisters & their heirs
 It. I ordain & give my negro woman called old moll her freedom & clear her from all bondage w^{ch} is due
 this day of my death likewise I allow her two barrels of Corn & one hundred pounds of pork to be paid
 yearly out of my Estate; - It I give & ordain old mora that was my usual Dr. woodhouse for her free-
 dom & clear her from all bondage after my decease allowing her y^e same as I have allowed old mora
 of my Estate; - It. I give unto my Loving Sister Elizabeth & her heirs y^e plantation whereon I now live
 with y^e land my father bought of Dawley called Saunders; - It. I give unto my Loving Sister Sarah
 & her heirs my two plantations lying together on wher on y^e w^{id}: Crooks now lives y^e other wher on
 Jⁿ. millison now lives & likewise that wher on dykemosoloy now lives: - It. I give all my Swamp land
 to be equally divided between my two Sisters & their heirs of their body Lawfully begotten. It. I give unto
 my two Sisters one hundred & fifty acres of marsh lying in y^e Tabbof pin marshes which I bought of m^r.
 Louis Conner to be equally divided; & to their heirs; - It. I give unto my Loving friends James Swelt & Nat
 woodhouse & Son of the woodhouse one hundred acres of marsh lying in y^e wash pattern which my father had
 of m^r. fulcher to be equally divided between them & their heirs; - It. I give & bequeath unto my Cuson Horat
 woodhouse Son of the woodhouse my Saddle pistols & holsters & silver hilted sword. - It. my will & desire
 that my Land that I have already given unto my two Sisters above mentioned may that if either of them die in
 their minority or without lawful Issue of their body then to go to y^e survivor of them & their heirs. It. I give
 & bequeath unto my two Sisters all y^e rest of my Estate of what nature soever either personal or real to be
 equally divided between them & their heirs; - And I do hereby ordain Nominate & appoint my Loving
 friends Capt. Anthony waller m^r. Reed Malbone my whole & sole Exors of this my last will & Testament. In w^{ch}
 witness I have hereunto set my hand & unto this 30th Day of May 1724
