bed & furniture to him & his heirs for ever to be at age at Eighteen: - I give and be-
queath to my son Joshua whitthurs & said negro woman to be at age at Eighteen: -
I give & bequeath to my son Jonathan whitthurs a piece of land fifty acres lying be-
tween his & peace I give to Joshua & Joyning to Enick whitthurs to him & his heirs for
ever & for him to be at Eighteen: I give & bequeath to my son David whitthurs a piece of
land whereon I live & my twenty five acres as I bought of Stephen Powe to him and his
heirs for ever; I give & bequeath to my son David whitthurs my molasses tank to
him & his heirs for ever and I leave to him of frank for & bringing up & teaching
of my three children: I give & bequeath to my sister in law Elizabeth whitthurs my de-
mare to her & her heirs for ever: and I leave all my personal Estate not given away
to be sold at a publick Sale & to be equally divided between my three sons Joshua & Jonathan
and David: - and for the due management of this my will I do appoint & ordain
my beloved friend Moses Prescott my whole sole Executor at this my last will and
Testament in confirmation of all & singular the promises I have made to my hand
and seals this third Day of June one thousand seven hundred and thirty four
