francis Talbott relict of Jane Moore who refused admittance of executors also required, James
being proposed by the oath of both the witnesses

In the name of God Amen I Adam Achis do make this to be my last will & Testament
Item I give unto my Daughter Katherine Achis all my land to her & her heirs lawfully
be gotten but it is my desire that my wife shall have her life in the said land I give
unto my said Daughter Katherine my negro wench Bessie her inheritance also
the now goather bed & furniture & one new chest thereof & a trunk & three drawers also
one small looking glass also Item I give to my wife below age my negro man
called Oliver his lifetime and after her Decease to my Daughter Katherine I give to
my wife one black Trunk & one feather bed & furniture & one mare & foal all my horses
hould stuff and four cows also of two sheep — Item I give unto my Little Cousin
Anne Achis one ewe lamb the son of my brother John Achis
