Virginia: being sick & weak in body but of sound mind & perfect memory blessed be god I do make & ordain this  
to be my last will & testament - Now I give & bequeath my soul into the hands of almighty my Creator hoping  
through the merits of Jesus Christ my Lord & Saviour to receive full pardon of all my sins & my body to be  
to be buried in a Christian manner thereto rest in hope of a Joyful resurrection at the last Day & as for what  
worldly goods I Lord of his Infinite mercy hath been pleased to bestow upon me I give & dispose of in  
manner following. Now I give unto my son Matthew Palest all that plantation & land called & known  
by name of Wolf Inairs to him & his heirs for ever. Now I give unto my son Matthew Palest and  
daughter Elizabeth Palest all that Tract of Land which I have at Brins River to be equally divided between  
them to them & their heirs. Now I give unto my daughter Eliz: Palest all that plantation & land which I  
have at head of Sam: Bonnets Creek to her & her heirs for ever. Now I give unto my wife & desire is that that parcel of  
Land which I bought of Mr. James Wythard may be sold either for money or a young negro or a  
negro or negro I do give unto my son Matthew Palest also I give unto my son Matthew Palest my negro
