widowhood & all belongeth to her. - Now I give unto my son William Liburn my two mares & all my
horses & cattle & all my farmes & land & all my slaves & all my household goods & money & all my
silver & gold & jewels & all my plate & all my linen & all my clothes & all my bed & bed-
chamber & I give unto my daughter Jane Liburn my remaining part of my Cattell & sheep not given to her &
my son & daughter William Liburn & Jane Liburn Exch. of this my last will Testament. In witness
whereof I have set my hand & fixed my Seal this 23. Day of November 1718

to be my last will & Testament. Imp. I give & bequeath my soul into hands of almighty my Creator hope
through the merits of Jesus Christ my lord & Saviour to receive full pardon of all my sins & my body to be buried
to be buried in a Christian manner thereto rest in hope of a joyful resurrection at glast Day & a. for what
worldly goods & lord of his infinite mercy hath been pleased to bestow upon me I give & bequeath of in
the following. Item I give unto my son matthew Paleot all that plantation & Land called & known
by name of woolf Sainr to him & his heirs for ever. Item I give unto my son matthew Paleot all
daughter Elizabeth Paleot all that tract of Land which I have at Boreas river to be equally divided between
them to them & their heirs. Item I give unto my daughter Eliz. Paleot all that plantation & Land which
I have at head of Sam. Benet's Creek to her & her heirs for ever my will & desire is that the said
Land which I bought of me I am either may be sold either for money or a young negro & it sat
money or negro I do give unto my son matthew Paleot also I give unto my son matthew Paleot my negro
