In the name of God Amen & in the year of our Lord 1720: February 4<sup>th</sup>: I James Carson of princ<sup>es</sup>  
Anne County being <sup>fit</sup> & sound in body but in a sound & perfect mind & memory I thought fit to settle  
& dispose of all my worldly goods first recommending my Soul into the hands of almighty God -  
whereat first gave it to my body to 4<sup>th</sup> earth to be buried in a Christian manner: - I then I give  
& bequeath to my son Thomas Carson one hundred & fifty acres of land whereon he now lieth to him  
and his heirs for ever it being his full part: - It I give to my son James Carson & my three  
daughters Eliz: Whithurst & Susannah Mors & Syner Wilbur to each of them one Shilling a-  
piece it being their full parts: - It I give & bequeath to grandson Carson Moore one young Ewe  
I then I give & bequeath to my son William Carson one hundred & fifty acres of land whereon he  
now lieth to him & his heirs for ever: - It I give & bequeath to my son William Carson & his heirs  
all my moveable estate both within Doors & without & do make & ordaine him my whole and  
sole Ex<sup>te</sup> of this my last will & Testament revoking all others & keep unto this only the Day and  
Date above written
